

#### **BISHOP DAVID C. FOSTER, SR.**

"A Man After God's Own Heart"



Bishop David C. Foster, Sr. was saved at Christ Temple Apostolic Church under the ministry of District Elder Robert B. Holman, Sr. on May 12, 1963. Before answering the call to lead a church, Bishop Foster served Christ Temple Apostolic Church in a variety of roles including Youth President and Advisor, Organist, Deacon, Teacher, Administrator and Associate Minister. While employed with the State of California, he managed and oversaw numerous health and social service programs including Aid to Families with Dependent Children, Community Care Licensing, Adoptions, Civil Rights, Child Abuse Prevention, Internal Audits, and more.

He accepted his commission to pastor in January 1981 and on September 6th of the same year opened Norwood Apostolic Community Church, which evolved over the years to be known as Greater Grace Church.

Bishop Foster currently serves as Founder and President of Greater Grace Ministries, Greater Grace School of Ministry, and President and CEO of Greater Grace Family Support Services. In addition to his pastoral responsibilities, Bishop Foster has served on several high-profile committees including State Black Infant Health, Sacramento County Black Infant Health, Black Adoptions, government and church partnerships, and community action groups and

committees. He has also served the California District Council, Pentecostal Assemblies of the World in a variety of capacities including Assistant Chaplain, Program Coordinator and Chairman of the Pentecostal Young People's Union, Vice Chairman, Area 3 Council, Suffragan Bishop, and Chairman of the California District Council.

Bishop Foster recently published his first book, "Journey into Purpose and Destiny," and has begun writing his second book. He passed the Mantle of Greater Grace Church (GGC), that he pastored for over 42 years, to his younger son, Michael A. Foster, a.k.a., Pastor Mike. Bishop continues to preach, teach, and share the Word of God with GGC and other congregations throughout California. His goals and objectives include accomplishing his purpose ordained by God and to maintain, through the anointing of the Holy Ghost, a positive influence upon his family, church, and community. Most importantly, he desires to continue to walk pleasing before God and to be recognized as "a man after God's own heart."

Bishop David C. Foster, Sr. is married to Lady Ethel M. Foster, his loving wife of 58 years, and from that union they were blessed with four wonderful children – David Jr., Michael, Marie, and Audrey, seventeen beautiful grandchildren and eleven great grandchildren.
